Burrendong Botanic Garden and Arboretum

Cathedral Cave

Formed over millions of years, the Cathedral Cave contains Wellington's famous stalagmite. This inspiring limestone structure reaches a staggering 15 metres in height.

Phosphate/Fossil Mine - Temporarily Closed

The Phosphate Mine is a restored underground mine from a bygone era. Steeped in history and showcasing Megafauna bones from the Pleistocene period 1 million years ago. Hard hat is supplied and must be worn in the mine at all times.

Gaden Cave

The Gaden Cave is the smaller of the two show caves but contains large amounts of stalactites, cave coral, flowstone and helictites. There are 240 steps in the Gaden Cave and requires a reasonable level of fitness.

Discovery Lab – Fossil Finding Session

Step into a scientific lab and examine fossils from over one million years ago! Learn about Australian Megafauna, dig through dirt from our Fossil and Phosphate Mine and see what you can uncover!
