1. Event Details

The '2022 Country Swimming Championships' will be held at Parap Pool Darwin, 77 Ross Smith Avenue, Parap NT from Saturday 1st to Tuesday 4th October 2022.

This event will be conducted under the Swimming Australia Rules and By-Laws.

3. COVID-19 Requirements

This event will be delivered in accordance with an approved COVID Management Plan. Swimming NT will work with NT Government to ensure the event abides to relative restrictions. Swimming NT will communicate with clubs the details of the COVID management plan closer to the event.

5. Program of Events

Heats will be swum in reverse order with the fastest heat first, with the exception of the distance events.

Distance events (400m IM, 800m and 1500m Free) are timed finals only contested in the morning sessions.

Relay events are timed finals and will be contested in the evening finals session.

6. Qualifying Times

The Qualifying Times (QTs) can be found on under the competitors tab on the event page of the website HERE

QTs must be achieved after 1st January 2020.

Open Events will be run as 13 & Over

The minimum age for swimmers competing is 12, this applies to all age able bodied and multiclass events.

No Qualifying Times will apply Multiclass Events.

Relay Teams may enter as NT (No Times).

Age is determined by the swimmer's age as at Saturday 1st October 2022.

7. Entry Procedures

Entries will open on Friday 24th June 2022 at 12noon ACT.

Entries will close strictly Sunday 18th
September 2022 at 11:59pm ACT, For all individual and relay events.

8. Eligibility

Swimmers are only eligible to compete **IF** they are registered with a club which is classed as regional to their state swimming association. To check please contact your state association.

9. Multiclass

Multi Class events are open to all eligible age group swimmers with a disability in sport classes 1 - 19.

Swimmers with a SM3 or SM4 classification may contest the 200m Individual Medley as a 150m Individual Medley.

Swimmers may compete with provisional classifications. There will be no qualifying times for MC events.

Multiclass athletes will compete in the relative heat in the morning session, Finals will be in age groups 12-15 and 16 & Over Male & Female.

10. Accreditations

Accreditation can be collected from the accreditation box at the event entry on premeet or competition days. Accreditation passes must be visible at all times and are strictly non-transferable.

To apply for an accreditation please check the events page on the Swimming NT website.

Clubs are advised that they will need to apply for their accreditation passes, including Team Manager and Coaches using the link mentioned above. All individuals are required to have a current and valid Working With Children Card (WWCC).

Applications for Accreditations close at the same time as entries.

11. Self-Marshalling

Self-marshalling will be in place for this event. Athletes will be instructed by the check starter to move behind the blocks once the event (or timed final) ahead of them has entered the water.

Swimmers will only be permitted to enter the self-marshalling area as follows:

- 50m events 8 heats prior to their heat
- 100m and 200m events 4 heats prior to their heat
- 400m events 2 heats prior to their heat

 800m and 1500m events - 1 heat prior to their heat

Self-Marshalling will take place for all heats and timed finals; for finals refer to next item.

12. Finals

All finals will be marshalled in the marshalling Area.

Any swimmer entered in the first or second event of the final's session, who fails to report to the marshalling area at least 10 minutes prior to the scheduled start of the session, may be deemed to be a withdrawal.

For all subsequent finals, any swimmer who fails to report by the start of the event, at least two events prior to their event may be deemed as a withdrawal.

Both reserves are required to marshall for final events

13. Seating

Seating for all athletes, coaches, clubs and spectators will be around the competition pool. Space is not allocated and cannot be reserved.

14. Livestreaming & Results

Results will be published around the venue and on meet mobile.

The event will be available to stream via a provider determined closer to the date.

15. Photography

Photos and videos will be taken throughout the competition. If you have any concerns, please contact admin@nt.swimming.org.au prior to the event.

16. Merchandise

Merchandise for this event will be available via the stand during pre-meet and all days of competition. The stand will be located near the main entrance.

17. Medical

If any attendant requires medical attention, please make yourself known to the facility staff as they are trained in first aid and CPR.
