Major Armstrong has participated in numerous operations of freedom and liberty. Upon initial enlistment she served with 89th military police brigade in Desert Storm. Twice she has participated in the peace enforcement operations in Bosnia and Croatia. Her dedication and service to the Sinai as the force transportation officer and company commander assisted the multinational observer mission and most recently deployed to Afghanistan for 14 months as the chief of plans and distribution for the 82nd sustainment brigade.

Theresa retired after serving 27 years of service with her Husband, and Australian Army Veteran, Mick Armstrong and their 3 children, Alexis, 14, Eleanor, 12 and Ewan 10.
