Performance Pathway Program Terms and Conditions

Accepting and Maintaining a position on a SNSW Squad

Swimmers may only accept a position on one (1) Swimming NSW Squad each year, with the default being set to the highest level of achievement.

All NSW squad members must complete the following documentation prior to being confirmed on the squad:

- 2020 Swimming NSW Team Agreement and Informed Consent
- Online ASADA Level 1 and 2 education (Level 2 must be renewed annually)
- Match Fixing e-learning
- Any other required content (advised upon squad selection)

Swimmers are required to attend all allocated squad activities. Should the athlete be unable to attend any activity due to medical, school, other, SNSW must be notified at least five (5) days prior to the activity date. Written document/s must be provided outlining the reason the athlete is unable to attend. If insufficient notice is provided, the athlete may be liable for any associated costs. Swimmers must attend all activities to receive full squad apparel and equipment.

It is the responsibility of the squad member to ensure all conditions of the Team Agreement are met. The squad may be amended at any time by the NSW Technical Lead or SNSW Coaching Director whereby an swimmer's squad status is withdrawn based on a failure to comply with the appropriate agreements or the swimmer meets another selection criterion during the course of the year.

Swimmer Withdrawal from a SNSW Squad

A swimmer wishing to withdraw from a SNSW squad may do so by informing the SNSW Coaching Director or Pathway Program Manager in writing at any time. Any equipment loaned to an athlete through the Program must be returned upon withdrawal. Athletes who do not return equipment will be liable for the cost of all outstanding equipment. The swimmer will also be responsible for all associated camp costs if withdrawal is less than seven (7) days from departure date.

Competition/Camps

SNSW squad members are required to attend the below SNSW and Swimming Australia (SA) major meets and activities*:

- SNSW Meets long and short course:
 - SNSW Age Championships (age group athletes)
 - SNSW Open Championships (open athletes)
 - Sydney Open Meet (open athletes)
 - SNSW Open Water Swimming Championships (open water squad members)
- SA Meets:
 - Australian Age Swimming Championships (age group athletes)
 - Australian Swimming Trials (open athletes)
 - Australian Short Course Swimming Championships (open athletes)
 - Australian Open Water Swimming Championships (open water squad members)
- SA State Teams Short Course Championships (where eligible and selected)

^{*}Swimmers may be exempt from the above meets upon discussion with the NSW Technical Lead or SNSW Coaching Director.
