

Conditions of Entry

- 1. Meet is approved by the South Eastern Swimming Association (SESA) and Swimming NSW Limited.
- 2. Meet will be conducted under the rules of Swimming Australia and Swimming NSW.
- 3. Age as at 19th January 2020.
- 4. Events will be conducted as timed finals. Events may be conducted as mixed gender events. Multi Class events may be swum with age-group events.
- 5. The Meet Director reserves the right to amend the program of events and conditions of entry as required.
- 6. Events 35 and 36 "Dash for Cash" will be the fastest seven Male and Female 50m Freestyle times from events 19 to 22 who will be eligible to swim in the Jack Mathieson Memorial Splash for Cash. Prize money for Final (Male and Female): 1st place \$50.00, 2nd place \$25.00, 3rd place \$12.00
- 7. Medals will be awarded to the first three places in 50m All Age events in the following age groups: 8 yrs/under, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 yrs and 15/Over.
 Medals will be awarded to the first three place getters in 100m events for 10 years/under, 11, 12, 13, 14 yrs and 15/Over.
 Medals will be awarded to the first three place getters in all other events. Ribbons awared to all 10yrs/Under non-place getters in 50m events.
- 8. Entries close once the entry limit is reached or the closing date **6pm Monday 13th January 2020**, whichever occurs first. No further entries will be taken once the entry limit is reached. No late entries accepted
- 9. Results will be submitted to SESA and Swimming NSW and uploaded to the National Results Database.
- 10. Meet programs will be available for download on-line via the SESA website and the Bomaderry website. A limited number of programs will be available for sale at a cost of \$5.00 each.
- 11. Free parking. Bomaderry Aquatic Centre Pool entry fees may be levied by pool operator for coaches, spectators and swimmers.
- 12. All clubs will be asked to supply time keepers.
- 13. A Qualifying Time (QT) has been applied to events 65, 66, 67 and 68. The QT is 6:00:00 and is based on the swimmers 400m Freestyle time. Times will be verified once the meet closes, and entries will be withdrawn and fees refunded if an athlete enters without having met the qualifying standard. Swimmers entering the 800m and 1500m events must supply time keepers.
- 14. Swim club BBQ will be running. Pool kiosk open. A lunch break will be taken during the day after event 34.
- 15. Entry Fee \$6.50 per individual event.
