POOL ACCESS POLICY

Swimming New South Wales Ltd recognises that, from time to time, various people have the need to access the field of play during swim meets. By necessity, access to this area is restricted and only persons authorised by Swimming New South Wales are permitted access.

Authorised personnel includes but is not limited to:

- Appointed Technical Officials & Volunteers (*must have a valid WWCC*)
- Swimmers who are entered in events of the swim meet
- Accredited Coaches who meet the requirements listed below
- Support Staff who have been approved by Swimming NSW (*must have a valid WWCC*)- including approved Multi-Class Support Persons (must have event support pass with them at all times)
- Swimming NSW Staff
- Security personnel and venue lifeguards
- Media personnel
- Swimming NSW invited guests

The Swimmers' change rooms/toilets are part of the "Field of Play" and are out of bounds for non-swimmers, including parents and coaches.

The granting, controlling, and monitoring of the physical access to the pool deck and the area of competition is important to the safety of persons authorised.

Coaches must meet the requirements of the [Coaching Pool Deck Access Policy](#), which requires them to:

- a) Hold a current valid membership with SCTA (Swim Coaches & Teachers Australia)
- b) Have completed the SNSW Meet Registration Form
- c) Have a current & valid Working with Children Check

Individuals that require pool access to assist swimmers in the event that their Club coach cannot attend, or they do not have a Club coach, may apply to Swimming NSW to be granted pool deck access by contacting Swimming NSW and applying for a support pass. A WWCC is required.

Sport Science staff and Team managers (where applicable) may apply to Swimming New South Wales prior to the meet and must display their pool deck accreditation at all times. **This access privilege may be revoked at any time by the Board, its authorised representatives, or the Technical Manager.**

POOL DECK & FIELD OF PLAY

- At all times during competition at this meet the pool deck must be kept clear of athletes & their equipment. Athletes are only permitted to be in the competition area if marshalling or competing or speaking to their coach.
- When athletes are not competing, they and their belonging must be located behind the barriers in the warmup area (but not obstructing access for Coaches and athletes using the warmup pool) or in the appropriate Grandstand.
- Only permitted persons (athletes, coaches, approved support staff and Technical Officials) will be permitted to be on pool deck and in the warmup area.
- Accordingly, the Swimming NSW Field of Play Policy will be strictly applied at this swim meet.

Points shall be allocated in order of placing of first claim members of Clubs in all New South Wales Championships, refer Rules GR 5 and GR12.3.

NOTE:

1. Where a swimmer is disqualified or does not achieve the standard qualifying time for the event, points shall not be awarded.
2. Where two or more individual swimmers are accorded the same placing's the appropriate points shall be allocated for that placing and the next one or more respective numerical placing's shall be deleted accordingly.
3. Where visiting swimmers are placed, points shall be awarded only to the NSW registered swimmers in order of their finish in the event.
