

## Integrity education for appointed officials

As of **1 March 2020**, all Swimming Australia appointed officials are required to complete the following online integrity education courses:

- Safe Sport
- Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) Level 1
- National Integrity of Sport Unit Matchfixing

On completion of these courses, a digital certificate is available, and this must be uploaded to Swim Central for record keeping.

Below are instructions on how to complete these requirements.

### 1. Create an account or log in to Swim Central

All participants within the sport, including staff, position holders and directors need to have an account on our sport management system, **Swim Central**.
