- (i) All participating Clubs must be affiliated with SNSW. Competitions hosted by non-affiliated clubs will not be approved or covered by the insurance of SNSW.
- (ii) For the above meet to be designated as a qualifying meet for Swimming New South Wales and Swimming Australia events, the following minimum standards must be met:
 - The competition must be conducted under the Rules of SNSW;
 - Pool length dimensions must be 25 metres or 50 metres;
 - SAL Accredited Referee and Starter appointed to the meet must fulfill these roles at the meet;
 - MM Results must be uploaded to the Database within 168 hours of the completion of the meet in accordance with the instructions provided;
 - MM back-up of the meet must be submitted electronically to your area representative in accordance with their Rules.
- (iii) All Area Championships must satisfy SNSW Competition Strategy.
- (iv) The meet must be conducted in accordance with the [Pool Depth Guidelines](#) adopted by Swimming Australia.
