During the Day further training and assessments to build on the working knowledge gained previously will be conducted. In addition, Judge of Stroke, Recorder and Referee training will be provided.</p> <p>Areas may request support from the SNSW TSC.</p>	<p>Activities: TOs currently appointed to State Meets are nominated by their Area to attend the National A Squad Meet.</p> <p>The National A Squad is run over a weekend and significant presentations and developmental opportunities will be made available to enhance the TOs' knowledge base whilst providing networking opportunities with TOs of a similar level throughout the State.</p>
<p>Selection: It is desirable for TOs to have attended the Achiever Squad Area Development Day prior to accepting a position to represent the Area at the Achiever Squad Meet at SOPAC.</p> <p>Each Area may recommend a maximum of 2 candidates.</p> <p>Individuals may also nominate directly to the SNSW TSC who will select and appoint the participants, which may exceed 2 per Area in number.</p>	<p>Selection: It is desirable for TOs to have attended the Target Squad Area Development Day as well as also officiated at the LC Area Championships.</p> <p>Achiever Squad participants from the previous year will be invited.</p> <p>Each Area may recommend TO's showing potential.</p> <p>Individuals may also nominate directly to the SNSW TSC who will select and appoint the participants, which may exceed 2 per Area in number.</p>	<p>Selection: Applicant TOs ideally would have previously been appointed to a Swimming NSW Meet prior to submission of the nomination.</p> <p>Each Area may recommend TO's showing potential.</p> <p>Individuals may also nominate directly to the SNSW TSC who will select and appoint the participants, which may exceed 2 per Area in number.</p> <p>The SNSW TSC will recommend TOs from this program to attend the State Age Teams Meet conducted by Swimming Australia.</p>
